zekiel spoke of the future and things in the fu-



Israel Will Know

Israel will know he says: ⁹" 'Then those who live in the towns of Israel will go out and use the weapons for fuel and burn them up—the small and large shields, the bows and arrows, the war clubs and spears. For seven years they will use them for fuel. 10 They will not need to gather wood from the fields or cut it from the forests, because they will use the weapons for fuel. And they will plunder those who plundered them and loot those who looted them, declares the Sovereign LORD.

It will take Israel seven years to use up the fuel energy left by their enemies. They will be reminded for seven years of God's faithfulness to them. They will not soon for get. They will spend seven months just burying the bones of their enemies. Then Israel will know the Messiah and will come into full relationship with him. See:
